

TRAMPOLINES AND CLIMBING STRUCTURE INDEMNITY

1. The owner of any erf which contains a trampoline and / or a climbing structure exceeding 2 meters from the ground level shall ensure that access to such is controlled.

2. TRAMPOLINES AND CLIMBING STRUCTURE REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 A wall or fence shall be provided by the owner of a site which contains a trampoline and / or climbing structure exceeding 2 m from the ground.
- 2.2 To ensure that no person can have access to such trampoline and / or climbing frame from any street or public space or any adjoining site other than through;
 - 2.2.1 A self-closing and self-latching gate with provision for locking in such wall or fence, or
 - 2.2.2 A building, where such building forms part of such wall or fence.
- 2.3 Such wall or fence and any such gate therein shall not be less than 1,2 meters high measured from the ground level, and shall not contain any opening which will permit the passage of a 100 mm diameter ball.
- 2.5 The constructional requirements of such fence or gate shall comply with the requirements contained in SANS 1390.
